TOWN OF PITTS TOWN, COUNTY OF RENSSELAER

A Local law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law Section 3-c.

**Section 1. Legislative Intent:** It is the intention of this Local Law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes which may be levied by the Town of Pittstown, County of Rensselaer, pursuant to General Municipal Law Sec. 3-c, and to allow the Town of Pittstown to adopt a budget for (a) for town purposes (b) fire protection districts and (c) any other special or improvement district governed by the Town Board for the fiscal year 2017 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal law Sec. 3-c.

**Section 2. Authority:** This Local Law is enacted pursuant to subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law Sec. 3-c, which expressly authorizes the Town Board to override the tax levy limit by adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Town Board.

**Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override:** The Town Board of the Town of Pittstown, County of Rensselaer is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2017 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount specified in General Municipal Law Sec. 3-c.

**Section 4. Separability:** If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law on in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall have been rendered.

**Section 5. Effective Date:** This Local Law shall tax effect immediately upon filing with the NYS Secretary of State.
