A Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Pittstown was held May 30, 2017 at the Town Hall, Tomhannock, New York. Those present included Supervisor, Verna Hansen, Councilpersons, Matthew Curley, Tanya Lipinski, Erin Maxon and Jason Eddy.

Supv. Hansen called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. She advised that the purpose of the meeting was to officially review and award the bid for the repointing of the bricks at 97 Tomhannock Road. There were two bids received, and upon recommendation of Eric Gradoia from Mesick, Cohen, Wilson & Baker, the Architect for the project, motion was made by Curley, Second: Maxon to accept the bid from PCC Contracting in the amount of \$16,825 and \$5.34 for each additional linear foot as the best value.
